

FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents and Community Members,

In the 2012-2013 school year, Banks High School received an Overall State Rating of Level 4. That means our students are performing and graduating at a level that is slightly above average in comparison to students at other Oregon high schools.

Key academic highlights:

- 91.5% met/exceeded state standards for reading
- 79.8% met/exceeded state standards for math
- Our graduation rate for students who attended Banks High School all four years increased by 5 percentage points.

While we are very pleased with the increase in achievement as outlined in this report card we also acknowledge an area of focus for this coming year. Providing focused instruction on improving student writing, which saw a decrease in student's meeting/exceeding, will be a key component of staff development.

We look forward to working together over the course of the upcoming school year to insure that all students reach their potential.

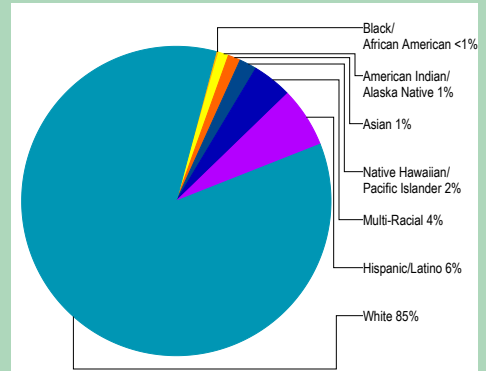

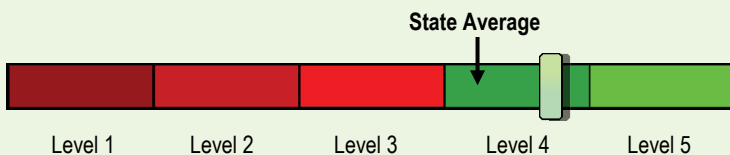


OVERALL STATE RATING

HOW ARE STUDENTS AT THIS SCHOOL PERFORMING COMPARED TO THOSE AT OTHER SCHOOLS?

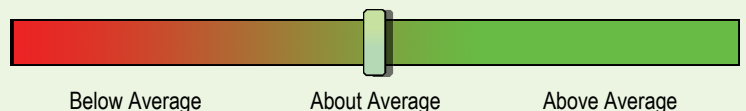
The overall state rating is intended to summarize this school's particular successes and challenges. It is based on a combination of up to five factors. Three of these factors come from standardized test scores in reading and math: student achievement, student growth, and the growth of underserved subgroups. High schools are also rated on the overall graduation rate for the school and the graduation rates of underserved subgroups. Please be aware that this rating is based mainly on high-stakes testing and accordingly, represents a limited view of student performance. Other aspects of this report card are designed to put this rating in the proper context.

Compared to all schools statewide in 2012-13, this school is rated as Level 4.



- Level 1** = Falls into the bottom 5% of schools
- Level 2** = Falls between 5% and 15% of schools
- Level 3** = Falls between 15% and 44% of schools
- Level 4** = Falls between 44% and 90% of schools
- Level 5** = Falls into the top 10% of schools

Compared to high schools with similar student demographics in 2012-13, this school's rating is about average.
