Board Member Qualifications

A person is eligible to serve as a Board member if he/she is an elector of the district. An “elector” means an individual qualified to vote under Section 2, Article II of the Oregon Constitution. The individual must be 18 years of age or older, registered to vote at least 20 calendar days immediately preceding any election in the manner provided by law and must have been a resident within the district for one year immediately preceding the election or appointment. Members are elected at large by position.

No person who is an employee of the district is eligible to serve as a Board member while so employed. A person who is an employee of a public charter school may not serve as a member of the Board of the district in which the public charter school that employs the person is located. A district or charter school substitute bus driver in a district with an average daily membership of 50 or less may serve as a Board member.
