

Dear Parents and Students of Banks School District,

A few updates for you heading into next week.

- 1) We will continue to provide breakfast and lunch for children ages 1 to 18 at Banks Elementary School from 10 am to 12. The elementary pick-up site is daily meals only. We will also be delivering to Buxton School from 11:00 a.m. to 11:20 a.m. and Timber Junction on Hwy 26 from 10:25 a.m. to 10:45 a.m. on Tuesdays and Fridays. Children will be able to pick up 3 meals on Tuesday and 2 meals on Friday to cover for the week at these 2 delivery sites. Forest Grove School District is also delivering to Visitation School in Verboort at 11:30 a.m. and Glenwood Store on Highway 6 at 11:30 a.m. daily. Banks School District students can access those Forest Grove School District drop off points as well.
- 2) We will be starting our Distance Learning for All on Monday, April 13<sup>th</sup>. Packet pick-up will be from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. at each school. Reminder that the elementary will be park and walk-up (please leave children in the car) and the middle school and high school will be drive-thru (please stay in your vehicles). Packet pick-up and turning in completed work will only be on Mondays through the rest of the year.
- 3) During the school closure, the parking lots surrounding Banks High School will have available wireless networks. The three main wireless networks are:
  - BSD-DOD: For staff devices owned by the Banks School District
  - BSD-iPads: For student devices owned by the Banks School District
  - BSD-Guest Wireless: Publicly available Wi-Fi

In order to connect to the Guest Wireless network, guests will need to select the BSD-Guest Wireless option, open up an internet browser on their device, and agree to Banks School District's Wireless User Agreement.

We have boosted the signal at our district to make our high school parking lot a WiFi spot for all. Thank you to Max Sigander, our technology director, for accomplishing this task.
