Children will be able to pick up 3 meals on Tuesday (for Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday) and 2 meals on Friday (for Friday and Monday). This will cover meals for the entire week. All meals will be at no cost. Hope you had a great Labor Day weekend and we look forward to the start of the school year.
