

NAMING SCHOOLS

It is the intent of the Board to select names of schools in the District in which the students and parents may take pride. Personal prejudice or favoritism, political pressure and current fashion shall not influence the selection process. The following categories are suggested:

1. People
Names of distinguished men or women who have made outstanding contributions to the community, state, nation, or general welfare or humanity. Names of living people are not acceptable.
2. Places
Names of recognized historical and geological landmarks of the area.
3. Themes
Thematic names which reflect the character of the community culturally and historically or which identify it by reference to indigenous and characteristic flora and fauna.

Names for consideration may be presented by chosen committee.

The name selected is intended to encompass all facilities on that school's site.

Final authority for naming schools rests with the Board.
