HIGH SCHOOL CLASSES/COURSES FOR EIGHTH GRADERS

It is the policy of the District to allow eighth grade students, who are qualified, to take designated high school classes/courses. High school credit may be granted. Upon parental request, courses completed for high school credit taken prior to ninth grade will be recorded on the transcript and included in the cumulative grade point average. No courses taken prior to the ninth grade will appear on the high school transcript nor will high school credit be granted unless specifically requested in writing by the parent. Credits taken before ninth grade will not be used to reduce below 24 the units of credit to be completed in Grades 9 through 12 for high school graduation.

Staff will notify parents of the option to have courses taken prior to ninth grade for high school credit recorded on the transcript and included in the cumulative grade point average upon enrollment in the class.

Parents will complete the Request for Credit for High School Classes/Courses for Eighth Graders form. Copies of the parental request will be maintained in the student's cumulative file at the middle school and a copy forwarded to the high school which the student will attend.
