Provides factual knowledge, has educational significance, incorporates high artistic & readability quality from authorative sources to empower students to make informed decisions in their daily lives.

Shall be consistent with and provide support along with enrichment to meet district's general education goals, selected program goals and the objectives of specific courses

Authentically represent the histories, contributions and perspectives of individuals with diverse backgrounds and identities, including materials by content creators of all cultures.

READING ENGAGEMENT

DEFINITION: Read to pursue lifelong intellectual, personal, and emotional growth.

Standard 1: Develop an appreciation for reading.

Standard 2: Comprehend, interpret, and evaluate informational and fictional text.

Standard 3: Building reading skills and behaviors for lifelong learning.

Supports, stimulates and enriches varied interests, abilities, backgrounds, identities and developmental maturity levels of students served, promotes appreciation for content literacy.

Provides content accessible in a wide variety of languages and/or physical and virtual formats for ease of use and/or to provide accommodations to enhance comprehension.

Earns favorable reviews from standard secular, professionaly recognized reviewing sources and/or authorative subject matter experts, including authentic reviews from communities represented in the materials.

SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

DEFINITION: Share knowledge and participate ethically and productively as members of a democratic society.

Standard 3: Participate collaboratively, respectfully, and productively as a member of a democratic society.

Guideline
